## CALL FOR PAPERS

It is our pleasure to announce that the 5th International Workshop on Historical Document Imaging and Processing (HIP 2019) will be held in conjunction with ICDAR 2019, on September 20-21, 2019, in Sydney, Australia. It will be a 1.5-days event, with sessions on the first day and a half-day excursion on the second.

The workshop brings together researchers working with historical documents and is intended to be complementary and synergistic to the work in analysis and recognition featured in the main sessions of ICDAR, the premier international forum for researchers and practitioners in the document analysis community.

## WORKSHOP TOPICS

The topics addressed in this workshop encompass the entire processing chain from image acquisition to information extraction. We include the growing importance of machine learning in this processing chain, such as convolutional and recurrent neural networks, and we also encourage the presentation of entire projects in the context of historical documents.
